

DESCRIPTION OF SATURDAY SHORT MODULE IN FRENCH Beginner level (A0/A1)

Target Audience

This training is aimed mainly at the UL stuff and people financed by an organisation.

Aims

- Communication and Vocabulary:
 - To interact in French in everyday life situations
 - To face up to any immediate or urgent need
- Language: to acquire grammar basics to express yourself
- Sociocultural: to learn the communication codes and social skills in France

Methodological Approach and Teaching Method and Tools

- Teaching is focused on communicating, interacting and apprehending cross-cultural differences.
- The learning aims, process and contents are based on the CECRL (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages).
- Working on all the language skills (speaking, listening, writing and reading)
- Various course material: authentic documents, documents created by teachers, teaching sheets from textbooks and French as a Foreing Language websites

Training content

- Introducing yourself
- Talking about your daily activities
- Expressing yourself simply about your tastes
- Shopping, buying goods
- Asking or giving information, communicating with the administration
- Getting somewhere, suggesting an outing and inviting

Organisation of the Training
